

CONCEPTS


The Internal Life based on **False assumptions**, that is, assumptions that the spectators make that don't accurately describe reality.

We magicians can influence, and to some extent control, the attention, perception and memory the spectators by hacking strategies that normally are effective (and efficient) such as focusing, filtering out, anticipating, simplifying and completing information using patterns of previous experiences.

At a practical level we accomplish that using false points of departure (passive) illusions (active)

GENERAL PRINCIPLES OF CONSTRUCTION

- **PRINCIPLE OF EFFECTIVENESS:** The method must be effective, fulfill its function, it must not be reverse engineered by the spectator.
- PRINCIPLE OF EFFICIENCY: It must use the less resources as possible to be effective.
- PRINCIPLE OF CLARITY: It must produce the clearest effect possible, minimizing any possibility of confusion
- PRINCIPLE OF PROPORTIONALITY: The method must be proportionate to the purpose it seeks.





CLASSIFYING THE METHOD: BY THE GOAL THAT THEY FULFILL

- Method that sets up the effect (indirect use)
 An illusion that creates or consolidates a false assumption to be used later
- Method that manifests the effect (direct use)
 An illusion that that us used and take place at the same time the effect does.
- > Both



CLASSIFYING THE METHOD: BY ITS EXTERNAL APPEARANCE

False or Secret Character

False: Has External Life, imitates a real action (False Shuffle)

Greater requirements of finesse in the Execution

Secret: It has no External Life: (Top change Greater requirements of Coverage

NOTE: The false or secret character is not inherent in the technique but in how we chose to use it (Gabriel Pareras)



COVERAGE

Cover for the mehod, but not the method itself, <u>a veil that clouds spectator's attention or judgment</u>. Pure coverage does not create e a false assumption.

- Physical: 3 degrees (Ascanio): Dissolution, Attraction and Deviation
- Psychological


PRINCIPLE OF MINIMUM COVERAGE

"Always apply the minimum coverage necessary"







AT THE LEVEL OF EFFECTS: CAUSALITY

Causality is defined as the relationship between one event (the cause) and a second event (the effect), in which the second event is understood as a consequence of the first.





AT THE LEVEL OF EFFECTS: CAUSALITY

3 Strategies to fight causality in magic

> Separate the cause from the effect

Establish multiple causes for one effect

> Do not repeat the same cause - effect relationship





AT THE LEVEL OF EFFECTS: SEQUENTIAL AND NON-SEQUENTIAL

In **Sequential Construction** the method is structured in such a way we always work for the effect that will happen next. No work is carried out for further effects that also the method is usually concentrated in a few moves.

The Counterpoint in **Non-Sequential Construction**, the idea is structuring the method, so we work resolving methods of effects that will happen after the effect to immediately follow




AT THE LEVEL OF EFFECTS: SEQUENTIAL AND NON-SEQUENTIAL

Sequential Construction




Non-Sequential Construction




SPECIFIC GUIDELINES AT THIS LEVEL OF ANALYSIS: ACTIONS

- Do not finish an action with a tricky move
- Get rid of handlings to set up techniques (weld moves)
- Do not place moves in moments of high attention
- Do not concentrate too much method in time and space
- The method that builds itself



ANALYZING THE CONSTRUCTION: 3 LEVELS









METHODS AND RESOURCES THAT ENHANCE CONSTRUCTION

- They can be used to create the illusion of false continuity
- They can store resources secretly to use later
- They can carry out more than one internal purpose at the same time





SPECIFIC GUIDELINES AT THIS LEVEL OF ANALYSIS: MOVES

- Susceptibility of slow execution
- Nature of the method to be different form the nature of the effect it produces
- Singular Methods
- Exploitation of resources and Reserve of Power
